**Diabetes Alert Dog
Application to bring to Camp**

Fully certified diabetes alert dogs with current vaccinations are welcome at camp. However, since the presence of your dog will affect your camp experience, there are several factors which should be taken into consideration before making the decision to bring your dog to camp.

- 1) The camper must provide proof of the dog's certification and current vaccinations before the start of camp.
- 2) The camper will be totally responsible for all aspects of the dog's care including feeding, relieving, and waste removal.
- 3) The camper will be responsible for providing all necessary supplies and equipment for the dog including food (in a sealed, rodent-proof container), rewards, dish, leash, and bags for waste disposal.
- 4) The camper will be expected to have the dog on leash and under control at all times.
- 5) Numerous distractions such as dogs and other animals, active play situations, and food will exist at camp. The camper must be able to maintain control of the dog regardless of these circumstances.
- 6) The need to care for the dog may preclude the camper's participation in certain activities such as canoeing and some games.
- 7) Camp staff will not be held responsible for the dog's health and/or safety.
- 8) Failure to comply with any of the above requirements will result in the need for the camper's family to remove the dog from camp.
