YOUR CLUBS TAX EXEMPT STATUS MAY BE AT RISK !

In 2006 congress changed the tax laws requiring all tax exempt groups to file tax returns so the IRS could track them. These organizations had three years to file. This three year period was up in May, 2010. The date was extended to October 15, 2010. Most clubs have complied. If your club still has not filed there is a simple way to fill out the new form 990N. Go online to www.irs.gov and click onto the link on the home page. It requires answering about eight questions about the club.

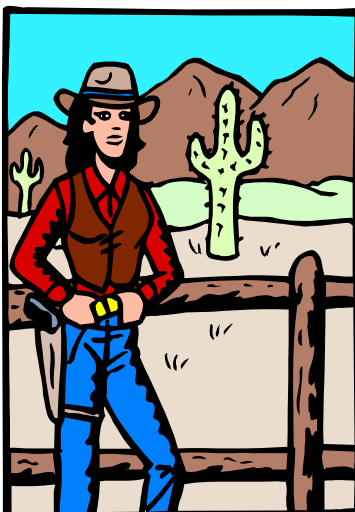
Rose's Run

During the 4 day event, 17 Lions from 10 different clubs in 4-C5 selflessly gave of their time and vehicles to transport us around Sacramento. What came of this event was a fuller understanding of RP folks about Lions, and Lions gaining a fuller understanding about people living with vision loss. A wonderful time was had by all and new friendships have been formed.

One of our attendees with RP, Rose Sarkany of Port Alberni, British Columbia, Canada wants to be run in the California International Marathon in Sacramento on December 5th. 2nd VDG Derek Ledda of District 4-C5 is spearheading a project in raising funds to help Rose live this dream and participate in the marathon. There are plans being made to also host a reception in Sacramento after the race for Rose to share about running a marathon with a visual impairment and meet with Lions.

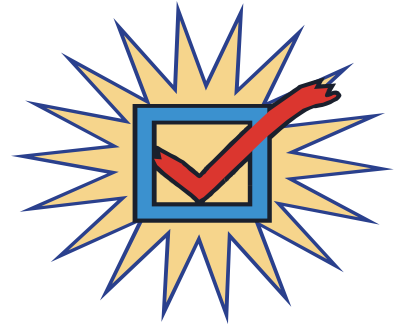

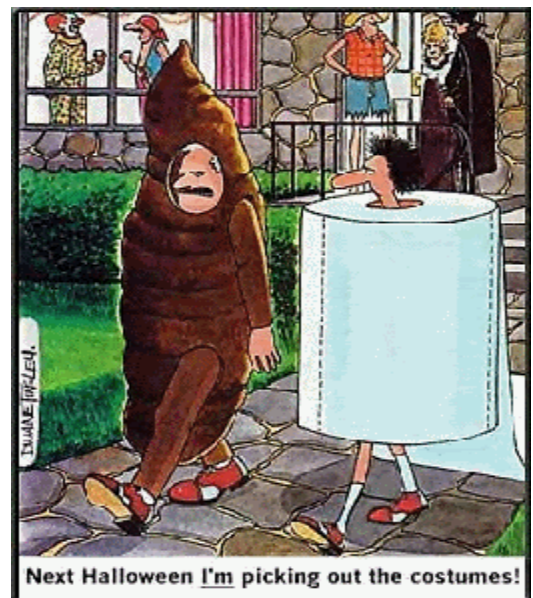


Hi to All,
